Father Ken's Note...

Final Weekly Diocesan Lenten Appeal - DLA Notice

This is the final DLA Weekly Notice. From this point forward, our diocese will only be offering monthly updates. Although this years DLA gifts can be received all the way to the end of the year, for the most part, the bulk of the gifts have been received.

Any parish that does not reach its goal by the official end of the DLA season will be billed the difference between what the parish raised versus what it needed to raise to reach its diocesan target. Out of the 78 parishes in our diocese, 73 have reached their goal. Only five parishes have yet to reach their goal but they are all close—the percentage breakdown for these five parishes, the amount of their goal that has been raised is as follows: 99.3%, 98.7%, 97.4%, 95.1% and 94.2%.

Locally, the picture for our four area parishes is as follows:

Saint Joseph has raised \$56,970.00 with their diocesan goal of \$37,946.00. They are at 150.2% of their goal.

Saint Mary has raised \$46,495.00 with their diocesan goal of \$35,961.00. They are at 129.2% of their goal.

Saint Margaret Mary has raised \$152,029.00 with their diocesan goal of \$125,724.00. They are at 121.5% of their goal.

Mount Saint Peter has raised \$96,501.00 with their diocesan goal of \$102,481.00. They are at 94.2% goal.

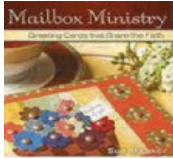

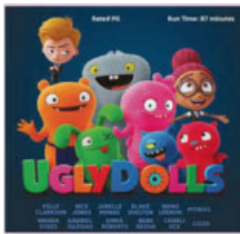
