



Father Ken's Note...

The Horse that wanted to be BEAUTIFUL!

The horse was beautiful and also it had many good qualities. But it wanted to be more perfect in every way. It especially wanted to have beauty unparalleled. One day the horse said to God, "O Lord, you have given me beauty. You have given me other good qualities. I am so grateful to you. But how I wish you could make me more beautiful. I would be extremely grateful if you could make me more beautiful."

God said, "I am more than ready to make you more beautiful. Tell me in what way you want to be changed." The horse said, "It seems to me that I am not well proportioned. My neck is too short. If you can make my neck a little longer, my upper body will be infinitely more beautiful. FALL BEREAVEMENT PROGRAM


If you have experienced the loss of a loved one during the past two years or longer (if needed), you are invited to participate in a six-week Fall
