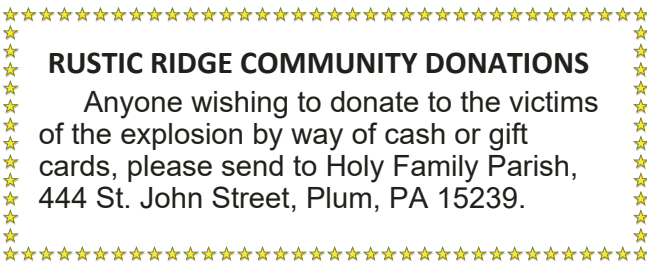

FAITH FIRST TEACHER AND AIDES NEEDED

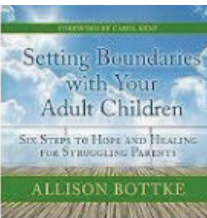

WANT TO BECOME A SAINT?

St. Louis de Montfort proclaimed that consecrating oneself to Mary, the Mother of God, puts one on a sure path to heaven. The United States has been consecrated to Mary on three separate occasions: 1792, 1846, and 1959. This fall, members of the NKCC are organizing a Marian Consecration for the A-K Valley beginning the weekend of November 4-5 with the formal consecration happening on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, December 8. During the November 4-5 weekend Masses, the first-day consecration prayer will be recited after all NKCC Masses, and from then on, the consecration is SELF-GUIDED.

33 DAYS TO MORNING GLORY by Fr. Michael Gaitley will be the consecration book. Every participant will take the minimum ten minutes daily to pray and read the corresponding reflection. On December 8, the formal consecration prayer will be recited for all participants in attendance at the NKCC Masses for this Holy Day of Obligation. Also, if any church or organization needs a further brief explanation at their September/October meeting, let Janet know.

This is an opportunity for all local Catholics to approach Jesus with prayers for the Church, especially for vocations, for world peace and of course with personal Intentions.
