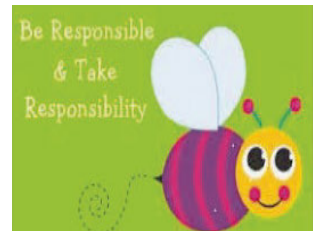
After nearly six months, Mr. James met his friend and asked him if he still has the expensive pen, and if he still loses cheap pens.

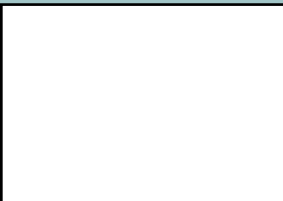
