OCIA/RCIA Update

What's New?

The NKCC welcomes Cody Parkinson, Crystal Willis, and Alexis Campana into the Christian initiation process. Cody and Crystal are unbaptized individuals (catechumens) who are looking to become members of the Catholic faith and to receive the initiation sacraments of baptism, confirmation, and Eucharist, at the Easter Vigil. Alexis, an already baptized candidate, is seeking full communion with the Catholic Church and will receive the Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil.

They began their journey in September and are attending weekly sessions. They learn about the Catholic faith through prayer, scripture, faith sharing, Church teachings, and discussion.

Rite of Acceptance Scheduled

As unbaptized people, Cody and Crystal will participate in the Rite of Acceptance declaring their intention to become members of the Catholic Church. The Rite is scheduled for Saturday, October 28, at the 4 pm Mass at St. Joseph Parish. Please pray for them and offer your support.

More News

You might have noticed a name change from the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) to the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults (OCIA) Recently, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops revised the process and are seeking final approval from the Vatican. The most recognizable revision is the name change from Rite to Order. Order is the more correct term since the sacraments are referred to as orders, i.e., the Order of Baptism. Christian Initiation will be in line with that designation as an Order.

How can you help with OCIA/RCIA?

Pray for Alexis, Cody, and Crystal as they proceed through the process. Ask God to give them an open heart as they encounter Jesus, steadfastness as they learn about the faith and discernment as they apply the Catholic faith to their lives.

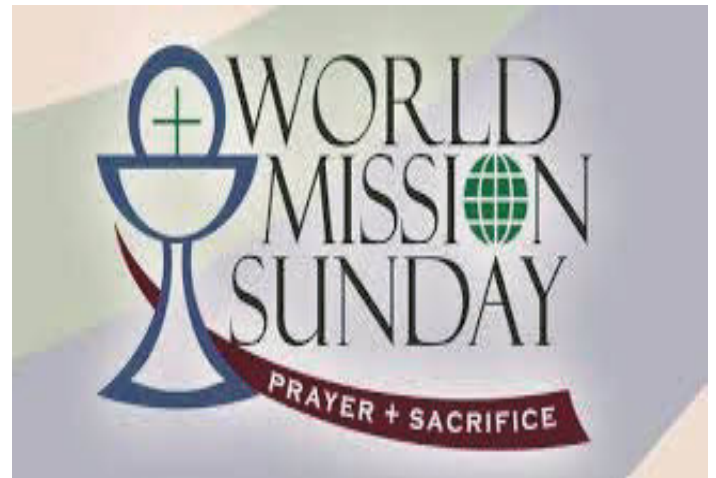

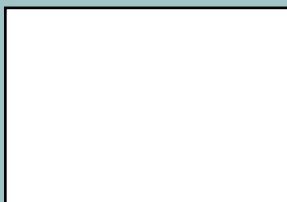
