

Our diocese requests that a continual effort be made to support the Eucharistic Minister in training and in understanding their role.

In conjunction with this request, the Eucharistic Ministers of Saint Margaret Mary, Mount Saint Peter, Saint Joseph and Saint Mary of Czestochowa Parishes are encouraged to attend an evening of reflection on the role of the Eucharistic Minister. The reflection will take place at Saint Margaret Mary Church on Monday, November 13 starting at 6:30 pm. The session will include evening prayer, a Eucharistic film, best practices, questions and answers. Session should conclude at approximately 8:00 pm. The "renewal" commissioning of all Eucharistic Ministers will occur in the "home" parish of each Eucharistic Minister on the First Sunday of Advent, December 2-3.

2024 MASS INTENTIONS

You can submit your request via postal, collection basket, or by dropping off at the office. They will be processed in the order of which they are received. Voice messages, emails, and requests submitted from the virtual office portal at www.newkensingtoncatholic.org will be processed when time permits.

Only two (2) Mass intentions per <u>registered family</u> will be accepted. Intentions for Holy Days, holidays, and special occasions will be selected by the Parish Office using requests which have not yet been scheduled.

- If requesting 2 Masses, one may be scheduled on a weekend, while the other must be scheduled on a weekday. Scheduled on a first come/serve basis, it is advisable to provide alternate dates on the form.
- ◆ Consider combining several family members in one Mass Intention, such as: "Deceased Members of the Smith Family" or "John & Mary Jones." For publication purposes, intention may be reworded by staff.
- A \$10 Mass stipend per intention <u>must</u> accompany your request. Intentions will not be scheduled until payment is received. Mark your submission envelope <u>"Mass Intention Requests"</u> and mail to the parish office, place in collection basket or drop off at the parish office.
 - ** If your requested date(s) cannot be honored, the closest date/day available will be chosen for you. We will make every effort to provide a confirmation call regarding your requests.




ADDOLORATA SOCIETY

A LOOK AHEAD — WEEKDAY MASS SCHEDULE EFFECTIVE MONDAY, DECEMBER 4

Starting Monday, December 4 of the first week of Advent, which starts the new liturgical year for the church, our morning Mass schedule will change a bit to reflect the addition of three morning Masses being offered at St. Mary. 
