A LOOK AHEAD — WEEKDAY MASS SCHEDULE EFFECTIVE MONDAY, DECEMBER 4

Starting Monday, December 4 of the first week of Advent, which starts the new liturgical year for the church, our morning Mass schedule will change a bit to reflect the addition of three morning Masses being offered at Saint Mary. With the adding of three weekday Masses at Saint Mary, Mount Saint Peter, Saint Margaret Mary and Saint Joseph, which for some time have had five weekday Masses offered in each parish, each of the three will have one weekday Mass taken from their respective schedules (this deletion occurred at Saint Margaret Mary months ago), thus allowing the three Masses to be offered at Saint Mary.

The weekday Mass schedule, starting Monday, December 4, will be as follows:

Saint Margaret Mary = 7:30 AM Mass - Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
(7:30 AM Mass on Friday was eliminated months ago)

Mount Saint Peter = 8:30 AM Mass - Tuesday, Wednesday Thursday, Friday
(8:30 AM Monday Mass is eliminated)

Saint Joseph = **12:30 PM Mass on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday
(12 NN Mass on Thursday is eliminated)

Saint Mary = **8:30 AM** on **Monday**, **12:30 PM** on **Thursday**, **9:30 AM** Mass on **Friday**

Please note that all 12 Noon Masses will now be moved to 12:30 PM.

Father Ken's End of the Liturgical Year Note

The old liturgical year is coming to a close with its memories and regrets. When we look back, we often wish we could live the days over again with the wisdom of hindsight. We could have done so much better. Time wasted could have been turned to better account. Angry words would have been so much better left unsaid. We wish we had spoken up for what we believed at the times when we were silent. We know it was sheer betrayal of Christ when we ignored a summons to responsibility.

Nevertheless, the past is dead and nothing can resurrect it. "The moving finger writes" and having moved on, nothing can change what I have written. Nevertheless, there is much to be learned from our regrets. If we wasted valuable time yesterday or the day before, we can learn to use time creatively today and tomorrow. If we spoke in anger, devoid of self-control, we need not repeat the folly now. If in anxious fear, we were silent when we should have defended our faith, we can speak out for the truth as we see it in the days to come.

Yesterday or yesteryear are no measures of what tomorrow can be. The Christian faith has been described as the "gospel of the second chance." It is precisely that. We are judged not in terms of what we did yesterday, but rather in terms of our moral recovery. The New Testament has much to say about "repentance." The word "repent" in Greek means simply "to turn around and go the other way." We are judged in terms of our willingness to "turn around and go the other way."

If the regrets of the liturgical year that is nearly done inspire us to make a "U-turn" with courage and hope, the past we have known can be a boon to the present. When the Prodigal Son "came to himself" and turned homeward after wasting his life in a far country he was forgiven. He made a new start and found as it was meant to be. We all have a second chance, even a third and fourth, to make a "U-turn" in our lives.

If we are burdened by regret, O God, grant us courage to change the direction of our lives, renew a right spirit within us, and guide us in the way of the everlasting. AMEN.

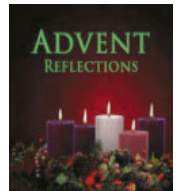

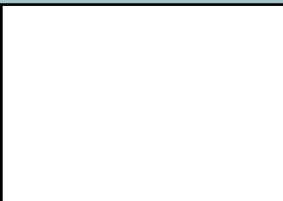

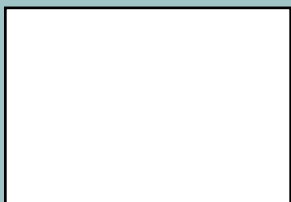
