



Regional Youth Formation and Regional Faith Formation



During this spring, the Faith Formation Director that served the four parishes of Saint Margaret Mary in Lower Burrell, and Mount Saint Peter, St. Mary and St. Joseph all in New Kensington, on her own decided to move on to another position. During the same period of time, the person holding the same position at the parishes of Christ the King in Leechburg and Saint Gertrude in Vandergrift decided to move on to another position at another parish.

It turns out that these departures are fortuitous. Bishop Kulick, in looking at the long range viability of our parishes and understanding the diminishing number of parishioners in our parishes, has realized that regional positions for Youth Ministry and Faith Formation need to occur. Currently the Regional Faith Formation Director for the six regional parishes of Saint Margaret Mary, Mount Saint Peter, Saint Mary, Saint Joseph, Christ the King, and Saint Gertrude's is being advertised. Anyone interested in the position can contact Mr. Reilly at our diocese.

The position of Regional Youth Ministry Director is not being advertised since the position has been filled. Our new regional youth ministry director is Heather Hensley. Heather has been the youth minister at Saint Margaret Mary, Mount Saint Peter, Saint Mary and Saint Joseph for the last year and a half, and has performed a stellar job. Heather, starting officially on July 1, will add the parish of Christ the King and Saint Gertrude on to her director responsibilities. During the month of July, Heather will introduce herself during the Masses at Christ the King and Saint Gertrude. She is a well-known person at the other four parishes.



Once the regional faith formation director is hired, that person and Heather, our regional youth minister, will have their central office at Saint Margaret Mary in Lower Burrell. Linda Reno, our Faith Formation/Regional Youth Secretary, will also have her central office at Saint Margaret Mary.
