



Eucharistic Adoration

This Lent "Exercise Your Gifts and Talents to Glorify God."

When President Kennedy entered Congress and began his political career he was told, "The way to get along is to go along." Well, that is one way for us to find our place in the world. We can simply go along with the tide, believe what those around us believe, do what they do, say what they say. It is a comfortable way to live, except for the fact that we become frightfully weary of ourselves and life becomes "intolerable and a torment." One reason why there are so many people with emotional problems and nervous exhaustion is that, in going along, they do violence to themselves. In going along, we can become cyphers, victims of the choices and decisions of other people. In going along, we deny the very essence of our being.

Life becomes meaningful, however, only when we exercise our gifts and talents to "glorify God" with integrity and independence, faith and fortitude. Some years ago, at the Empire Exhibition in Johannesburg, South Africa, a peculiar technical glitch on the opening night of the exhibition caused many people to be disappointed. It had been planned that a 3,000 foot beam of light, cast by a 14 million candle power beacon, would be thrown into the sky. But when this occurred, no beam of light was able to be seen, for the engineers had not taken into account the Johannesburg climate. The light was invisible because there was no humidity, no dust, no cloud for it be reflected against. Light, unless it strikes an object, is invisible. Likewise when we simply "go along", our light that we can offer as a person, strikes nothing and is invisible. Our light does not shine in the darkness of our time unless it challenges things as they are. We, as Christians, are not here to go along. Jesus did not stir up the dust of His day by going along. He stirred up the dust of His day so that His efforts of good could be seen by all.

Jesus says to all of us this Lent, "Let your light shine that all people may see your good works and give glory to your Father." My prayer, our prayer, this Lent needs to be this: "O God, in whom I trust, grant me the courage to stand against the tide of the many, help me to battle the injustice of the world and my community. Let me stir up the dust in my battle for good, so that my light, my difference may be seen. Keep me from sitting back and just going along to get along, because in this, I who can change the world, become invisible."

DIOCESE OF GREENSBURG SAINT JOSEPH PILGRIMAGE

March 18, 2024

Bishop Larry J. WHAT'S NEW IN NKCC RCIA - A LOT!

Since September, our adult catechumens and candidate have received instruction in the Catholic faith and strengthened their relationship with Christ. They've been guided by their catechists and sponsors throughout the process. Sessions are conducted at Mt. St. Peter Parish on Tuesday evenings at 7:00 pm.

Our younger catechumens, Karsen, and candidate, Taylor, have been catechized by Heather Hensley through her position as Pastoral Associate for Youth and Young Adults. She currently serves the NKCC, St. Margaret Mary, Christ the King and St. Gertrude Parishes.

St. Joseph parishioner, Michael Karmazin, received his initiation sacraments when baptized as a baby into the Russian Orthodox faith. He will make a Profession of Faith to the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. Michael has also been attending sessions.

In October 2023, our unbaptized catechumens, Cody, Crystal and Karsen, along with their sponsors, participated in the Rite of Acceptance at St. Joseph Parish. The catechumens declared their intention to study and receive the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil

On January 28, 2024, candidate Alexis Campana and her sponsor, Bill Sadecky, participated in the Rite of Acceptance at Mt. St. Peter. Alexis is baptized and stated her intention to continue her studies and receive the Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Eucharist at the Easter Vigil.

The next step for our RCIA participants is to attend the Rite of Sending at St. Joseph Parish. The Rite will be celebrated Sunday, February 18, at the 9:30 am Mass. The participants will then continue later that afternoon with the Rite of Election at 3:00 pm at Blessed Sacrament Cathedral, Greensburg. At that time, they will meet Bishop Larry Kulick and confirm their intentions to become fully initiated Catholics at the Easter Vigil.

During the Lenten Purification and Enlightenment Phase, the catechumens and candidates learn about the



Lenten practices of the Catholic Church and prayerfully prepare for the scrutinies, a Penitential Rite of the Church. The scrutinies will be celebrated March 3, 10 and 17 at the 10:30 am Mass at Mt. St. Peter.

Laugh and cry with him; thank, praise, and adore him; ask for his help, protection or consolation; or just sit in silence, rest and bask in his love, open to receive any graces he wishes to give to you. There is nothing too little to talk with him about. Nothing is unimportant to him. Think about taking Jesus up on his offer to "Come away with me by yourselves to a quiet place and rest a while," Mark 6:31.
