



CATECHESIS CORNER - HOW IMPORTANT IS EASTER ON THE CHRISTIAN CALENDAR?

Easter is the greatest high feast on the Catholic/Christian calendar. Every other Sunday is rooted in Easter. It is so huge that the church celebrates an octave (8 days) to prolong the JOY of the Resurrection of Our Lord, Jesus. Easter celebrates the defeat of death and the hope of salvation. The Easter Vigil begins in darkness. Outside the Church, the celebrant blesses the new fire and then lights the new Paschal Candle from this new fire, saying, "May the light of Christ rising in glory dispel the darkness of our hearts and minds." The new Paschal Candle is the symbol of the light of Christ. The celebrant proceeds into the church while the candles of all the faithful are lit from the blessed fire of this new Paschal Candle, illuminating the darkened church with the light of Christ.

The Easter Proclamation (EXSULTET) is sung. It is a majestic proclamation of the Resurrection of Christ. The Liturgy of the Word moves us through the outstanding deeds of the history of salvation. The Gloria is then sung, with the bells being rung, praising God the Father and the Lamb, Jesus.

Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia becomes our song throughout the Easter season of 50 days.

Luke 24:34 The Lord is risen indeed!

Father Ken's Easter Note...

No Cross, No Easter.

To endure is to hang on when there seems to be no hope. It is the capacity to last a little longer when our powers seem to be exhausted. It is the ability to stand pain or hardship and to keep on keeping on. It is the power to go on undismayed after everybody else has quit the race.

If ever a man had the capacity to endure, it was Jesus. He faced the misunderstanding of his disciples, the opposition of his enemies, the suspicion of Rome, the denial of Peter, the betraval

enemies, the suspicion of Rome, the denial of Peter, the betrayal of Judas, and the fickleness of the crowds. He endured the dusty roads of Palestine, the fierce heat of the land and storms on the Sea of Galilee.

When the crisis of the Master's life came, he endured scourging, a crown of thorns, the brutal weight of the cross on the Via Dolorosa, the scorn of those who watched him on the way, and the torture of crucifixion. Nevertheless, he kept on, his spirit unbroken. He went on when everyone else had "left him and fled" to safety. He pushed beyond the cross to an Easter dawn.

When those who followed him through Judea and Galilee were ready to give up the struggle, he said to them, "By your endurance you will gain your lives." It was so, for life always is tempered by hardship and hurt. Without some great burden on the heart, there is no music on the lips. Without something to overcome, there is no greatness of soul. Without opposition and struggle there can be no growth of mind and spirit. Without the cross, there can be no Easter Dawn.

May the Easter experience live in our hearts forever. When we are tempted to give up some painful struggle, grant us peace to endure, as Jesus. Steady our minds in times of trial and keep us on our feet with the strength of our Resurrected Lord.






