



Father Ken's Note...

Protecting Our People

Recently our Diocese of Greensburg established a Police Department. The first task of the newly formed Diocese of Greensburg Police Department centered on offering police protection at all the Catholic schools in the diocese. This first task, and a much needed one at that, has been achieved. Every Catholic school in our diocese has an armed Diocese of Greensburg police officer in each school. Our school, Mary Queen of Apostles, employs two officers, one for each building.

With police presence in our Catholic schools established, parishes throughout the diocese have the ability, if they wish, to have police protection from the Diocese of Greensburg Police Department at their respective parish Masses. Mother of Sorrows Parish in Murrysville is the first parish in our diocese to employ police protection from the diocesan police department to have, as in our schools, an armed police officer at each Parish Mass.

I am grateful to Bishop Kulick, as I would imagine all diocesan parishioners are, for establishing the Diocese of Greensburg Police Department and for offering police protection for Parish Masses. Starting with the April 20-21 weekend Masses at Saint Margaret Mary, Lower Burrell and Mount Saint Peter, Saint Joseph and Saint Mary of Czestochowa, New Kensington, of which I am the pastor, we will have one officer at each of my parishes and at each of our weekend Parish Masses.

Three officers will cover our four parishes starting on April 20-21 and moving forward. **Please note:** the weekend Mass schedule at Saint Mary and Saint Joseph is such that one officer will provide coverage for both parishes. The officer will be at the Saint Joseph Parish for the 4:00 pm Saturday Vigil Mass, and on Sunday mornings, the officer will be at the 7:30 am Mass at St. Mary, then move on to Saint Joseph Parish for the 9:30 am Mass, then move back to Saint Mary's for the 11:30 am Mass. Another officer will be stationed at the three Masses at Saint Margaret Mary and another officer will be stationed at the three Masses at Mount Saint Peter.

The Diocese of Greensburg police officers are all retired State Police or Municipal Police officers. The cost to each parish for the police coverage from the diocese is \$32.50 per hour. To help defray the cost, we will be adding an envelope to your envelope packets, designated for police protection. We will also be placing in the book holders on the backs of the church pews, loose envelopes also designated for police protection.

As police protection for our four parishes begins on April 20-21, we will be the second, third, fourth and fifth parishes in our diocese to offer police protection at our weekend Masses. According to the chief of our diocesan police department Chief Ryan Maher, he is planning in time to offer classes to train parishioners on how to protect themselves, their families, and their brothers and sisters in Christ should an incident requiring immediate action arise in church. I will keep everyone posted when these classes start.

I am not going to spend any time trying to convince anyone that these are scary times with shootings in schools, churches. malls, universities and local shootings in various venues, are not made up stories to scare, but real stories that frighten. I would imagine that most, if not everyone, is disappointed that our world has come to this as I would also imagine that most, if not everyone, affirms the need.

Diocesan Lenten Appeal Update

I like to learn from my mistakes. Last year (during the 2023 DLA) out of a sense of enthusiasm for Saint Joseph Parish, I wrote in the bulletin that they were the first of our four parishes to hit their DLA target. I was happy for them, and I ridiculously thought that everyone else would be. That turned out to be a mistake, a huge mistake. The number of letters I received by U.S. Mail, e-mail and text informing me that the DLA was not a competition, and that my happiness for them was misplaced, was incredible.

So this year I have decided not to make the same mistake twice. Out of a smattering of caution, I am not going to mention, I repeat, that I am not going to mention that Saint Margaret Mary, Saint Joseph and Saint Mary of Czestochowa in the same week and on the same day, all hit their DLA targets and went beyond. I am hoping that by not mentioning this, I should be safe.

Holy Week and Easter Masses

On behalf of Father Joel and Father Bimbot, I would like to express our appreciation to all who attended our Holy Week services, Easter Vigil and Sunday services. The crowds were fantastic. Our parish staffs and support people on every level did a masterful job in making sure all went well. Above all our attendance really reflected the appreciation all people have for their God and our Savior.

CATECHESIS CORNER - WHAT IS DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY?

Today we celebrate a most important and special day, Divine Mercy Sunday. St. Pope John Paul II, formerly Pope John Paul II, canonized Maria Faustina Kowalska on April 30, 2000 and declared the Second Sunday of Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday.

St. Faustina was directed by Jesus to spread the Divine Mercy devotion. Jesus appeared to her in 1931 as the "King of Divine Mercy" wearing a white garment, with rays of white and red light flowing from his heart. Jesus' revelations are recorded in her Diary.

We received a question that ties in with Divine Mercy. Was Judas condemned to hell? Is God all forgiving? Bishop Fulton Sheen in his book, "*LIFE OF CHRIST*", stated that the tragedy of Judas' life was his failure to repent as he fell into despair and chose suicide. Bishop Sheen continued that the sin of refusing to repent cannot be forgiven. God forgives repented sins. However, God alone judges hearts, and we do not know if Judas did repent at the end.

Jesus told St. Faustina, "The more a soul trusts, the more it will receive."

May we all join in praying: Jesus, I trust in you. Jesus, I trust in you. Jesus, I trust in you. St. John Paul II, pray for us. St. Faustina, pray for us. Pope John Paul II passed to eternal life on the eve of Divine Mercy Sunday, April 2, 2005.

To receive special graces that our Lord promised for Divine Mercy Sunday, one is to receive Holy Communion worthily on Divine Mercy Sunday (or the Vigil of Divine Mercy Sunday), make a good confession beforehand, stay in the state of grace, and trust in His Divine Mercy. 
