

CATECHESIS CORNER - DO YOU REMEMBER YOUR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION?

Do you remember the excitement, the weeks of preparation, the wonder and awe of that moment? First Holy Communion celebrations usually occur during the Easter season, the period between East-

er and Pentecost. There are many Catholics throughout the world making their First Holy Communion during this season.

"The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. ... For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church. namely Christ himself, our Pasch." (CCC 1324)

Unfortunately, according to a Pew Research study, only 31 percent of Catholics believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. However, Jesus told his disciples, "Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood have



eternal life, and I will raise them up on the last day; for my flesh is true food and my blood is true drink. Those who eat my flesh abide in me and I in them." (John 6:34-36). Would that we could experience the awe and wonder of our First Holy Communion each time we receive the Body and Blood of Christ, realizing Who we are inviting into our hearts and souls.


